



Pioneering project delivering on all fronts

Weston-super-Mare Town Hall and North Somerset Council's customer services and staff offices are now together under one roof in the newly refurbished Weston-super-Mare Town Hall. Just weeks after opening its doors to the public the refurbished Town Hall picked up its first national award - Public Building Retrofit Project of the Year.

Cllr Nigel Ashton, Leader of the Council said: "The early signs of this pioneering project are that it is delivering on all fronts and to be recognised with a national award so soon really is the icing on the cake".

Demco worked directly with North Somerset Council on the library project designing with the emphasis on shared services

and self service. A feature is the large central counter which acts as a central point for all the shared services; it's completely reconfigurable to account for any change in services or visitor needs.

Over 9,000 new books have been bought for the new library over a wide range of categories and nestled among the shelves are seating areas where visitors can sit and relax. Free WiFi brings the library online and self service kiosks means that the library can extend its opening hours. The North Somerset Studies library is now even more accessible with extra study space, staff support and resources.
